Dear Friends,

If somebody calls me two-faced, they do not mean it as a compliment. "Two-faced" in common usage means insincere or deceitful. But today I am thinking instead of a certain ancient two-faced Roman god – Janus – from whom the month of January gets its name.


#### Special Visitor in January


